About CSA

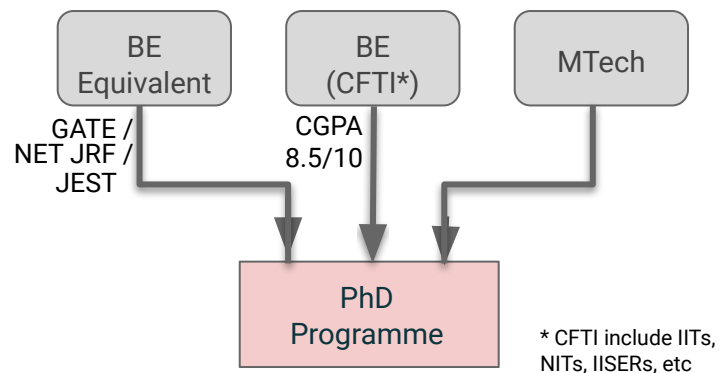

Mid-Year PhD Admissions at CSA

CSA invites applications for its PhD Programme. The typical duration of a PhD is 5 years. Students are paid a stipend of Rs 31,000 p.m. for the first two years and Rs 35,000 p.m. thereafter, and are eligible for on-campus hostel accommodation. The mid-year admissions are for the semester beginning in **Mar 2021**.

Eligibility

Students with a BE (or equivalent) with a valid GATE score or from a CFTI with a CGPA of 8.5 and above, or MTech degree holders, can apply. More details at www.iisc.ac.in/admissions.

Applications must be submitted **online** at www.iisc.ac.in/admissions. Shortlisted candidates will be called for an interview in Jan 2021. Semester is expected to begin Mar 2021.
